CHEMNITZ, ZWICKAU & MULDENTAL

As a city of culture with an industrial pulse, Chemnitz is on its way to being European Capital of Culture 2025. A city tour will give you an overview of the city. The Villa Esche is a must-see: it is a European architectural monument and one of the highlights of the European Henry van de Velde Route. The afternoon is free for you to explore the city on your own.

The Zwickau tourist region is full of surprises. The West Saxon city of Zwickau is known as THE AUTOMOBILE CITY. As a visitor to the August Horch Museum, you will gain unique insights through the integration of the 80 large exhibits as well as the multitude of automobile-related small objects in backgrounds and scenic presentations related to their time of origin. In the afternoon, you will discover the historic rooms of Waldenburg Castle.

In the Mulde Valley, the leisure adventures away from the big cities continue. On a steep rock in Central Saxony rises the most beautiful knight's castle in Saxony: Kriebstein Castle. After a tour of the castle, the journey continues to Wechselburg Basilica. Thanks to its porphyry elements, it is not only exemplary for the architectural history of the region, but also houses one of the most precious Romanesque works of art in the world with its massive rood screen. To round off the day, visit Rochsburg Castle. Situated on a rocky spur in the middle of a nature reserve, the castle, which was first mentioned in a document in 1190, watches over the Zwickau Mulde valley. Afterwards, it is worth taking a detour to the Choco del Sol chocolate factory.

From the 1st weekend in Advent, you can experience Christmas magic like a picture book in Chemnitz.

The Chemnitz Christmas market has become a magnet for visitors from all over the world. Ore Mountain folk art and medieval handicrafts create a very special flair that has a lot to offer for young and old alike: The 12-metre-high Christmas pyramid, candle arches and nutcrackers can be marvelled at over a cup of mulled wine, while jugglers, fire-eaters and musicians provide entertainment at the medieval market.

The first Advent weekend is particularly eventful: On Friday, 29.11.2024 at 16:00, the traditional Christmas market will open and on Saturday, 30.11.2024, you can experience one of the largest miners' parades in den Erzgebirge Mountains, with over 1.000 participants from 30 miners' guilds and associations from 13:00.

"BERGGESCHREY" – ERZGEBIRGE MOUNTAINS DAY TRIP

The "Berggeschrey" (mountain cry) used to resound through the Erzgebirge Mountains, heralding rich silver finds. Go on a discovery tour through a unique region rich in tradition.

After a drive through the beautiful Erzgebirge Mountains, you will reach the toy village of Seiffen, the centre of traditional Erzgebirge folk art. You will watch the creation of the smoking man, nutcracker or Christmas cot and pay a visit to the toy museum. After a lunch break in Seiffen, you continue to the silver city of Freiberg. Here you can experience the 800-year-old mining tradition at first hand on a guided tour of the historic old town and visit the magnificent cathedral. St. Mary's Cathedral is one of the cultural monuments of European rank. During the tour you can listen to the famous Silbermann organ.

"GLÜCK AUF!" – ORE MOUNTAINS DAY TRIP

Embark for a day on fascinating trails from the "gateway to the Erzgebirge Mountains" through the middle of a gently rising mountain landscape and discover this unique region.

Take a leisurely ride on the steaming narrow-gauge railway to Germany's highest town, the climatic health resort of Oberwiesenthal, at the foot of the Fichtelberg mountain, which is over 1200 metres high. Afterwards, you will travel to Annaberg-Buchholz, the place of work of the legendary arithmetician Adam Ries, a town where you can experience a variety of mining and craft traditions. The landmark, the St. Anne's Church, is the largest pure hall church of the late Gothic period in Saxony and is one of the most culturally and historically valuable examples of this architectural form. At the end of your excursion, you will take the mine train about 600 metres into a visitor mine, where you will see impressive evidence from the times of silver and cobalt mining and uranium mining by SAG Wismut.
